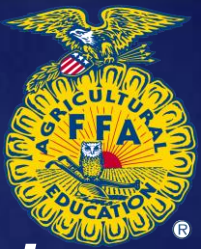

DEGREE CHANGES

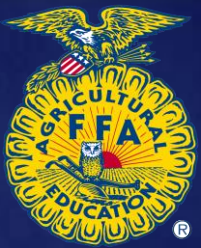


The following changes are for the 2011 award year:

- ***Chapter FFA Degree:***

- At least 10 hours of community service activities. These hours are in addition to and cannot be duplicated as paid or unpaid SAE hours

DEGREE CHANGES

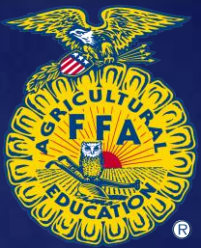


- ***State FFA Degree:***

- At least 25 hours within at least two different community service activities(NOTE: 15 more than Chapter Degree). These hours are in addition to and cannot be duplicated as paid or unpaid SAE hours

- Minimum of 5 *different* FFA Activities above the chapter level, and 3 *different* community activities. (Approved by Bd. of Dir., July 2008)

DEGREE CHANGES



• *American FFA Degree:*

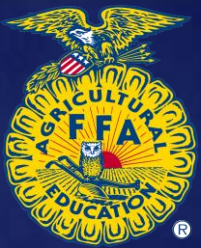
- Have a record of outstanding leadership activities;
- Have participated in at least 50 hours in at least three different community service activities (25 more than State Degree). These hours are in addition to and cannot be duplicated as paid or unpaid SAE hours; and

- These hours may be cumulative. Example:

- 10 hours required for Chapter Degree,
- 15 more hours are required for the State Degree
- 25 more hours are required for the American Degree, for a total of 50 hours.

- New application will be available for download in August of 2010

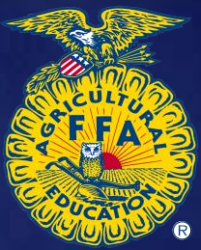
PROFICIENCY AWARD GUIDELINES



New Tennessee Proficiency Guidelines will be available August 2010 at www.tnffa.org under “Teacher Downloads”

Opportunities:

- Students may apply in more than one proficiency award area.
- Students may only win region and state in one award area.
- NO Regional level judging. One State Judging day. Each region must provide a minimum of 12 judges with at least 3 + years of teaching experience.
- New “Chapter Proficiency Award Summary” form submitted to state office. Applications brought to judging.

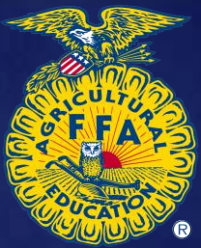

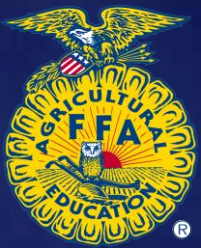

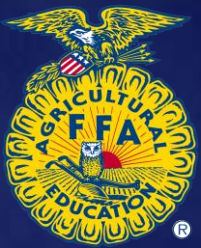

- Piloted with State Livestock, Meats, Floriculture, Nursery-Landscape, and East TN Livestock.

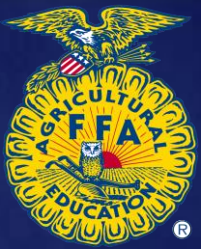

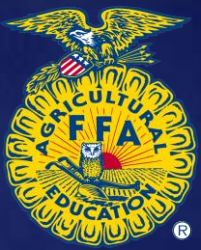
CDE Rules Cycle:

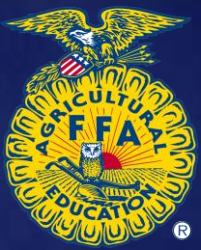

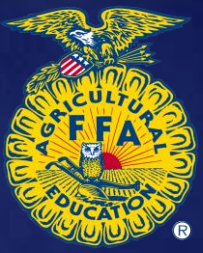

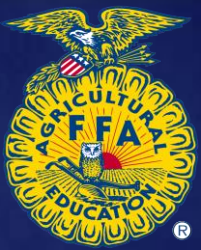
AFFILIATION FEE PILOT

 - Traditionally less than 50% membership



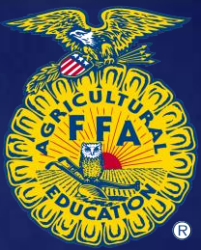
