

# Agricultural Services

**Purpose:** Members who work in custom equipment operation and maintenance, agricultural management and financial services, agricultural education related services, animal breeding services, custom baling, crop scouting, horse shoeing, taxidermy services, animal hospital services, custom and contract feeding services or other appropriate services offered through agricultural enterprises. Students with placement or entrepreneurship programs may enter in this area.

**Background:** Working in an entrepreneurship or placement program in agricultural services is a common supervised agricultural
