Purpose: FFA members improve the availability of fish and wildlife through practices such as land and water habitat improvement, development of new land and water habitat, trapping, Fish & Wildlife departments, Forest Service, Department of Natural Resources or the stocking of fish and wild game. Members competing in this area have an entrepreneurship or placement enterprise.

Background: Wildlife management is one of the most popular courses offered in Agricultural Education in Tennessee schools. Development and production of wildlife is an important environmental program.

Visibility: The sponsor of this award will be recognized in the following ways:

- Immediate press release recognizing the new partnership.
- Statewide recognition at the State FFA Convention in front of 2500 FFA members.
- Statewide media recognition through press releases in agricultural publications.
- Name of sponsor on plaques received by FFA members.
- Up to thirty applicants statewide annually.

Budget: The annual cost of this three-year commitment is \$500.00. This amount of support each year will provide for cost of award plaques with sponsor's name on each of three regional levels and on the statewide level and cash awards.

Expected Results: This partnership will generate added interest and excitement in this award area. Through this increased interest more students will focus their skill development in the area of Wildlife Production and Management.
